# Report your whereabouts through Chiba University Safety Confirmation System(ANPIC)

ANPIC collects and aggregates the safety information of students, faculty members, and employees in the event of a disaster, contributing to prompt disaster response. All students, faculty members, and employees are requested to complete [initial registration for ANPIC](#) in advance, to prepare for an unpredictable large-scale disaster.
