

# **[IMPORTANT NOTICE]**

## **Registration of Scholarship Applicants**

Those who wish to apply for scholarships that require a recommendation from the university (such as JASSO's Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Student and the other private foundations' scholarships) must apply for this registration. By signing up for this registration, you may apply for a candidate selection for scholarships offered within the school year of 2016 after that the university completes related procedures in the mid November. Students who are planning to apply for Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship are highly advised to participate this registration.

Students who are registered in first semester (spring semester) 2016 do not need to register this time. Students those whose spouse is a MEXT or Government Sponsored student may also apply for this registration.

**[Intended Students]** This registration is for the following international students at Chiba University.

1)	who will continue or enroll either as an undergraduate student or a graduate student. (Current and Newly-enrolled Students)
2)	who enrolled as a research student by April 2016. (Current Research Student) Notice: Research students who enrolled by October 2016 can NOT register this time.
3)	who are currently MEXT scholarship or Government Sponsored student whose period of scholarship ends in March 2017 and wish to apply for scholarships starting after April 2017.
4)	who were not able to sign up for the previous registration. (Need to submit "Written Statement of Reasons")

**[Qualification]** Eligible applicants must satisfy all the following conditions.

1)	International student who enrolls in Chiba University as an undergraduate students, a graduate student, or a research students during the school year when a scholarship granted. * *Must hold a "College Student" visa. Applicable to prospective students
2)	International student who does not exceed the minimum period required for graduation. * *Granted period of leave of absence may be excluded.
3)	International student who holds great academic standings and is never given any disciplinary actions within the past one year.
4)	International student whose monthly allowance from his/her family and relatives is less than 90,000JPY.
5)	International student whose annual income of his/her sponsor residing in Japan is less than 5,000,000JPY
