

Application outlines for Chiba University International House for Students
(October 2015 move-in)

1. Eligibility

- a. An applicant must not have lived in the International House in the past.
- b. An applicant must be a student of Chiba University with a resident status of “student” at the time of application and for the whole period of residency in the House.

* Smoking is prohibited at International House.

2. Application room

- a. Family room 3 rooms (approximate number)
- b. Couple room 9 rooms (approximate number)
- c. Single room 50 rooms (approximate number)

3. Period of residency

October 1, 2015 to August 31, 2016

4. Application deadline

July 13, 2015 to August 28, 2015 to ISD Nishi-Chiba

(Those students studying at Inohana and Matsudo campus can submit the application to the ISD branch in each campus during July 13 to August 19.)

You may also send the documents by post or email to International Student Division.

Upon receiving the application documents, we will issue reception number which is needed when you check the result of selection.

5. Application documents

a. Single room

- an application form (available at ISD)
- a copy of your Student ID card or certificate of entrance admission
- a copy of “Resident Card”

b. Couple room (room for married couples)

- an application form (available at ISD)
- a copy of your Student ID card or certificate of entrance admission
- a copy of “Resident Card”
- a copy of marriage certificate and *Jyuminhyo* of all the residents

c. Family room (room for married couples and their children)

- an application form (available at ISD)
- a copy of your Student ID card or certificate of entrance admission
- a copy of “Resident Card”
- a copy of marriage certificate and birth certificate
- *Jyuminhyo* of all the residents (including wife and a children)
