■What's English Camp in Nasu?:

The Kita Ward Board of Education organizes a 3-day English camp for junior high school students (8th graders, ages 13–14) in Kita Ward, Tokyo. The aim is to help them experience English in real communication settings and build confidence through fun cultural and outdoor activities with international student volunteers. This long-running program began in 2002. Every year, both Japanese students and international students discover, grow, and enjoy learning together!

■Eligibility:

- ① People who have the energy and enjoy being with young teenagers at the junior high school level.
- ② Must be proficient in English (regardless of nationality).
- 3 Must pass an interview with the EC staff.

■Fee:

Free!

■Remuneration:

20,000 yen per round

*Please note that each round participated in requires the student participant to attend a mandatory meeting the night before the program begins, and all camp duties must be performed.
