## [IMPORTANT] Application period for National Health Insurance premium reduction has started

New National Health Insurance payment slips arrive in June. Premiums are based on last year's income, so applying for a reduction between January and May may lower your cost. You can get Income Declaration forms at ISD or [download from Chiba City's website](#). See [samples of how to fill-in on ISD website](#) and submit to your ward office early to ensure changes apply. Scholarships are not counted as income. If you live outside Chiba City, check with your local office.

## From the Immigration Bureau

- If you have a job offer starting in April, apply to change your status from "Student" to "Work" by the end of January. Details are in the [Immigration Agency flyer](#). For changes to "Engineer/Specialist in Humanities/International Services" or "Researcher" you can skip some documents by submitting an [explanation sheet \(Jap\)](#).
- After graduation, return to your home country promptly. If you plan to start working or continue job hunting, you must change your status of residence from "Student" to another appropriate status. Students on leave, withdrawn, or absent for 3 months must also return. When leaving Japan, return your residence card at the airport.
