

## Necessary Procedures for International Students after Arrival in Japan

International students who will stay in Japan for more than 3 months (those who are eligible to receive a resident card, but not those who have "Temporary Visitor" status or a period of stay of less than 3 months. The following procedures must be completed at the city hall or ward office where you live within 14 days of your arrival in Japan.

1. Resident Registration
2. Enrollment in National Health Insurance
3. Enrollment in National Pension System (Those under 20 years of age are not required.)

\*Failure to follow the procedures may result in revocation of your status of residence or a fine.

\*Even if you have health insurance or a pension plan in your home country, you will still need to complete the procedures.

Various procedures, including administrative procedures, are in order.
