In the event of a disaster (you will receive a "safety confirmation e-mail" in the event of an earthquake of intensity Lower 5 or higher in Tokyo or Chiba)

Report your whereabouts through Chiba University Safety Confirmation System(ANPIC)

ANPIC collects and aggregates the safety information of students, faculty members, and employees in the event of a disaster, contributing to prompt disaster response. All students, faculty members, and employees are requested to complete <u>initial</u> registration for ANPIC in advance, to prepare for an unpredictable large-scale disaster.
